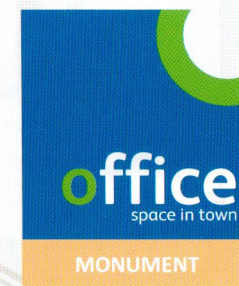

Drawing inspiration from the location by Customs House, Old Billingsgate fish market and the Thames. The building has been designed with a luxury nautical theme in consultation with Sunseeker to provide interiors influenced by some of the finest yachts in the world.

The building is also next to St Dunstan's in the East, opened by the City of London in 1971, this small and intimate space it is claimed to be the most beautiful public garden in the city. An imaginative planting scheme of unusual trees, wall shrubs and flowers grows amongst the ruined arches provides a calming space to relax.

The building not only has over 700 workstations it also has 15 nautical inspired meeting rooms that hold from 4 to 100 people, beauty salon, free meeting areas, stunning business lounge and a huge reception hall.

To top it all off is the deck, probably one of the finest roof terraces in London, with outstanding views of both the Thames and city skyline.
